- Junior athletes are required to perform Technical routine in each event they entered except Combo
- Juniors: 19 solos, 28 duets, 13 teams, 10 Combo
- Seniors: 5 tech solos, 6 free solos, 3 tech duets, 7 free duets, 1 tech team, 1 free team
- Total 93 routines

- Good size of the meet
- Convenient meet schedule (2 ½ days)
- Music collected before the meet via email
- Juniors: Top 9 solos, top 9 duets, and top 11 teams qualify for the US Junior National Championship
- Seniors: Top 6 solos, top 6 duets, and top 4 teams in each tech and free category qualify for the US National Championship
- All swimmers attending US National and US Junior National Championships need to have passed grade levels 1-4.
